Apply to be an AP Reader

Advanced Placement[®] (AP) Readers evaluate and score AP students' free responses, ensuring that high school students receive AP grades that accurately reflect college-level achievement in a specified discipline.

Each year in June, high school teachers and college faculty from around the world gather across the United States to participate in locations onsite, as well as to score online from home. During the AP Reading, Readers will:

- exchange ideas and experiences, as well as build friendships with a network of high school teachers and college faculty.
- score exam responses from AP high school students, with opportunities to score exams online from home.
- learn to apply a rubric consistently, which provides valuable knowledge for scoring their own students' essays back in the classroom.
- get compensated for training and scoring. Expenses, meals, and lodging are also covered for Readers who travel to a Reading site.
- earn Continuing Education Units (CEUs) and Professional Development Hours (PDHs).



Reader positions are available based upon test-taker volumes. Submitting an application does not automatically constitute your employment as a Reader. ETS (Educational Testing Service) reserves the right to withdraw an invitation prior to the scheduled AP Reading session based upon business needs.

Note: It your application has been approved and you were hired by £15 within the past 6 years with an active status, or you are currently an existing AP Reader with an active status, there is no need to reapply. To check your status please contact <u>APReader@ets.org</u>.

AP Readers will score student responses at Reading sites and from home. All onsite Readers must be able to work at the Reading event for 7 consecutive days. Readers scoring from home can work flexible schedules during the 7day Reading period; however, they must attend mandatory training on the first day of the event.

Qualified applicants in subjects with a high need for Readers have a greater likelihood of being invited to the Reading event in the year they apply.

It is not unusual to be invited to the Reading event in one year and not the next, especially in subjects where the Reader pool is deep. New or existing AP Readers in subjects with deep Reader pools may have to wait several years before receiving an invitation to the Reading.

Online Scoring

The Online Network for Evaluation (ONE) is ETS's proprietary software application that enables Raters to score testtaker responses and/or other submitted work via secure internet access. Raters typically score from their homes or offices, in accordance with ETS guidelines. Online scoring sessions may occasionally be conducted at regional sites.

The process for each testing program includes:

- System Training using online learning modules and quick reference guides. This training is generic and does not need to be repeated for each program or test.
- Content Training using online training sets or possibly scored on paper.
- Certification after completing the required certification test(s) online with successful results.
- Scheduling certified Raters enter their availability for open scoring sessions via the ETS online scheduling system. Schedules are confirmed by ETS based on the overall availability of Raters and scoring volumes. This process is also used to schedule prospective Raters for training and certification.
- Calibration most programs require Raters to take calibration test(s) daily prior to scoring.
- **Scoring** using online scoring application with access to prompt support materials.
- Mentoring on prescribed application of rubrics and testing program standards is provided by ETS Scoring Leaders throughout each scoring session via online feedback and other means of communication.

To certify and score using the ETS Online Scoring system, prospective Raters must have computer equipment that meets the minimum hardware and software requirements.

- developing scenarios that allow candidates to demonstrate their writing skills
- composing reading passages and lecture scripts pitched at the appropriate level of difficulty for testing nonnative speakers

- Position type: Paid. You will receive competitive compensation.
- Location: Remote
- Job duration: July 10, 2023-August 18, 2023 (6 weeks)
- Schedule: Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-5 p.m. U.S. Eastern Time

Job requirements

ETS is actively seeking candidates who can bring diverse experiences and perspectives to the item development work. The ETS Summer Institute workforce includes people from a variety of backgrounds, such as undergraduate students, graduate students, teachers, professors, department heads, professional writers and other working professionals.

To be eligible for this position, you'll need to have completed some undergraduate work and have:

- excellent writing skills
- strong English speaking skills, and knowledge of English grammar and vocabulary
- analytical skills
- attention to detail
- receptiveness to other perspectives

You'll need a very high degree of fluency in English, but you don't need to be a native speaker. While not required, experience in a business setting (including remote settings), as well as a background in second-language learning is preferred.

Additionally, you should be able to:

- work well individually and collaboratively
- accept constructive feedback
- manage your time effectively to meet targets

U.S. work authorization visa

You'll need to have appropriate authorization to work in the United States. If you don't currently have U.S. work authorization, you may be able to apply for a CPT or an OPT work authorization visa if enrolled at a U.S. university; check with your university's international student services office or program coordinator for eligibility *before* applying to the ETS Summer Institute. CPT visas can usually be acquired quickly, while OPT visas typically take longer. If you need a CPT or OPT visa, you should apply for one immediately upon accepting our offer.

3. Upload your cover letter, resume or CV, and 2023

work sample

Your cover letter, resume and work sample should be in Word documents. Make sure you change the filenames of your documents per the instructions below before uploading them.

- o Cover letter filename: [First and last name] Cover 2023
- Résumé or CV filename: [First and last name] CV 2023
 - Ignore the instructions to paste the contents of your résumé or CV into the résumé field — upload a copy instead.
- Documents which are not properly named will not be reviewed. If the application system changes the name of your document, that is okay.

Upload each document only once. You won't immediately be able to see that they were uploaded. Log out and log back in to check whether your documents were successfully uploaded.

If you submitted an application in the past, your old documents will still be attached to your account; you can't remove them. Upload your most recent versions; we'll only look at versions that contain "2023" in the title.

Be sure to complete the application process by January 30, 2023. We select applicants primarily on their performance on the work samples. Work samples will be evaluated in February and March, and you'll be notified of your status by March 30, 2023.
